


# Proper Waste Disposal

This guide outlines how to properly dispose waste in the Canton of Zug.



## Recycling Centers (Ökihöfe) / neighbourhood collection points

They accept separated waste types (neighbourhood collection points: glass and in some cases aluminium/can-steel or textiles).

## Green waste

In green standard containers with 2 or 4 wheels, collection occurs weekly. Branches/cuttings may be bundled (max. 1.50 m length and max. 20 kg) and must be placed outside.



**Food scraps (including meat and fish)**  
May be placed in the normal container; a compost-bag with grid-print is authorised.



**Kitchen scraps**  
May be placed in the normal container; a compost-bag with grid-print is authorised.



**Garden waste**  
In the standard container, bundled or in a compostable green-waste bag is allowed.



## General waste

Use blue Zeba fee-bags to collect waste. Dispose via underground containers or – if not existing yet – place at the roadside by 7 a.m. on the scheduled collection day. General waste bags are available in certain shops.
